

Northfield Companion: A Guide to Robbers, Witnesses and Others

The Northfield raid ended in tragedy when bank teller Joseph Lee Heywood was killed during the robbery and a Swedish immigrant was wounded in the crossfire between the Northfield citizens and robbers. The immigrant later died. Three of the eight James-Younger Gang members sustained mortal wounds. Two died in the street and one died during the capture. While the two James Brothers escaped, the three Younger Brothers were captured. One of the Younger Brothers died in prison and the two other brothers served twenty-five years in prison.

The authors have published *A Guide to the Northfield Robbers, Witnesses, Posse and Others*. The 238-page, nonfiction paperback book summarizes the Northfield raid. The book is comprised of over three hundred biographical entries and includes some genealogical information for witnesses, citizens, judicial and law enforcement officials, the robbers, the robbers' family members, as well as others who were affected by the raid. Also, approximately one hundred illustrations and photographs are included in the book.
